

Interview assignments (2)

There are two separate interview assignments. Both are brief, and there will be no additional homework assignment next week (we will use the data you collect now). Please use different people for the two parts of the assignment.

FIRST ASSIGNMENT. Collect statements of opinions about the City of Davis from five (5) people. Attempt to find people who have contrasting views— some who like Davis and others who don't. (Note that this refers to the **City of Davis**. not the University). If the person makes a long statement, you can either break it up into separate comments, or use the main point by itself. Put each one-sentence comment on a separate piece of paper. Bring comments to class and hand them in to the TA.

SECOND ASSIGNMENT. Interview 3 current dog or cat owners. The animal (or animals, if there is more than one) can be with them in Davis or at a parent home, provided the person sees it as "their pet." The person should be **either** a dog or cat owner; if they have both a dog and a cat, exclude them from the study. Write all the responses from each person on single sheet of paper (one sheet per person), using the question numbers below.

1. Type of animal: (dog) (cat)
2. What are the major satisfactions you receive from this animal?
3. What are the major disadvantages of owning this animal?
4. If anything happened to this animal, would you replace it with: (no animal) (dog) (cat) (other)
5. How outgoing and sociable is the animal with visitors?
(very) (moderately) (somewhat) (low) (not sociable)
6. How outgoing and sociable a person do you consider yourself?
(very) (moderately) (somewhat) (low) (not sociable)
7. Interviewee age
8. Interviewee gender: (Male) (Female)
9. Your name, NOT the person interviewed:
10. Date

Note that you are to complete **both** assignments above and bring the data to your section meeting.
