For a student to elect a Psychology minor and have it certified on his/her final transcript, the minor must be declared by the 10th day of instruction of the quarter of graduation (refer to the *Registration Guide* for deadline date).

Students should declare their minor online at students.ucdavis.edu.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

- **Psychology 1**
- Completion of **20** upper division Psychology units, including at least **one course from each of the Core Groups (15-16 units) plus an elective course**
- NOTE: PSC 41 is ***not required*** for the minor, although it is a *recommended* prerequisite for many Psychology courses.
- You must have a combined grade point average of **2.0** in *all* courses required for the minor.
